### **Covid 19: Madrassah update**

Dear Parent/Guardian

17<sup>th</sup> April 2020

Further to our letter on the 19<sup>th</sup> March 2020 the madrassah has had to make the difficult decision to temporarily suspend all Madrassah classes.

Whilst the current situation continues updates to the Madrassah will be posted on the Masjid website [www.masjidalfalah.org.uk](http://www.masjidalfalah.org.uk), the masjid notice board and receiver. **Please keep checking the website regularly for updates.**

### **Homework and Revision**

During this uncertain time, we urge all students to revise what they have learnt in the year so far. Whilst learning resources are available under the Madrassah section on the Masjid website, we strongly encourage parents to create an environment of learning at home by following the instructions below:

- Ensure your child is ready as they would normally be for madrassah – make sure they are with wudhu, wearing the madrassah uniform (topi, jubba/abaya, scarf etc) and ready by 5.00pm
- **5.00pm – 5.30pm:** Revise Quran sabak from the beginning of the madrassah year (September 2019). Read loud and clearly, ensuring the rules of Tajweed are followed. Foundation class students must practice 1 page every day.
- **5.30pm – 5.50pm:** Revise the lessons from the coursebook. Read up to 5 pages, slowly taking time understand what you are reading. Keep a note of which page you have read up to. You can read a different subject every day.
- **5.50pm – 6.20pm:** Complete the workbook activities that correspond to the pages in the coursebook you have just read, use the coursebook for help.
- **6.20pm – 6.50pm:** Revise surah, kalimah and dua, working your way down the memorisation sheet which is also available on the Madrassah website.

### **Additional notes:**

- Your child must sit in a quiet room, away from all distraction such as phones, computers, and tablets
- Ensure they are visible to you and not left alone by themselves
- Their kitaabs and Madrassah equipment must be treated with respect
- They must sit with etiquette and respect
- **You must make a note of what your child has prayed in their student diaries every day.**

A member of staff may be in contact to enquire if your child is following these instructions.
